eBird is an online platform and app that helps you find, record and share bird sightings while contributing to scientific research and conservation. Everyone is welcome, from complete beginners to expert birders.

Getting Started

Visit eBird.org or download eBird app.



1. Make an account.
2. Pick a spot to start recording.
3. Keep track of all wild birds you see and hear.
4. Submit your checklist.

Tips & Tricks

- Explore the website to find sightings near you.
- Install your area bird pack to use the app offline.
- Click on the species name to add comments or a breeding code.
- Not sure about a species ID? ID to a higher level like 'Hawk sp.'
- Avoid recounting individuals: Count only one direction of an out-and-back hike, or enter the highest number of individuals you see together at once.
- Submit your checklist even if you see no birds.
